The temporary MBE number assigned to your firm, W09-85, has now become your permanent MBE number which may be used in connection with any Howard County purchasing activities.


Your certification will expire two (2) years from the date of this **confirmation letter**. Recertification may be obtained by submitting a new application at least 45 days prior to the expiration date.
